"LIVING TRIUMPHANTLY"

"But thanks be to God who always leads us in triumphal procession in Christ and through us spreads everywhere the fragrance of the knowledge of Him. 2 Corinthians 2:14

As Christians, we have the joyful assurance that we can live our lives triumphantly. We have this victory because of Jesus Christ.
