"SEEKING GOD"

"Seek the LORD while He may be found; call upon Him while He is near." Isaiah 55:6

Aren't you glad that God allows us to have a personal relationship with Him? He wants us to seek Him; to look for Him. Jeremiah 29:13 contains a wonderful promise: ***"And you will seek Me and find Me, when you search for Me with all your heart."*** Isn't that reassuring?
